GOAL:

The goal of the Eagle Reader program is to encourage daily reading at age-appropriate levels.

RECORDING MINUTES:

Mark your minutes daily on the calendar provided. A student can be read to, can read to someone else, or can read on his or her own. Try to read every day. If you are unable to read on a given day, you can make up those minutes on another day.

TURNING IN YOUR CALENDARS:

Turn in the calendar on the day noted at the end of each month's calendar. If you are unable to attend school when the calendar is due, turn it in to your teacher as soon as you can. Please make sure the calendar is received within three days following the calendar due date. If you are unable to do so, please contact Dana Warner (Eagle Reader chair) at danalwarner@yahoo.com.

AWARDS:

If you reach your Regal Eagle goal, you will receive a purple Regal Eagle award slip and will be entitled to choose a free book from the Eagle Reader Clubhouse (the first of which will be in November). Bring your purple award slip with you on the day of Clubhouse and trade it in for a book.

If you reach the Eagle Effort goal, you will receive a yellow Eagle Effort award slip. After you accumulate 3 Eagle Effort award slips, you will receive a green Effort Bonus award slip, and you will then be entitled to choose a free book from the Clubhouse.
