Emergency Preparedness

Dear Parents of New Students (K-5)

The Maple Hills Emergency Container Program was established by the PTA and Maple Hills faculty. This container is located on school grounds and is provisioned with the necessary water, food, blankets, medical supplies, communications equipment and other items that would be used to take care of Maple Hills students and staff in the event of a major earthquake or other catastrophe.

As you are know, Maple Hills is accessible by only one road. This remote location makes it especially critical for our school to have this emergency container in place and fully stocked. Our goal is to keep adequate provisions on hand to care for the children and staff for up to 72 hours.

A program of this nature requires maintenance in order to stay viable. Water and food must be replaced every 5 years, batteries and medical supplies expire, etc. For this reason, the PTA requests that the families of all new students (K-5) donate \$15 per child to cover the cost of sustaining the program.

Please send a check made out to the Maple Hills PTA to school in an envelope marked “Emergency Preparedness”. This important program will only stay viable if we have enough funds to keep our emergency stores current.
