EDUCATION: A WORLD OF POSSIBILITIES.... MAPLE HILLS AUCTION NEWS

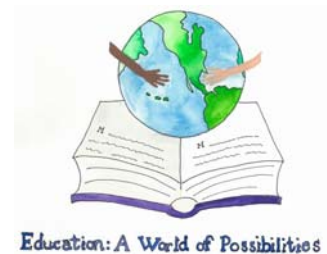
By the time this article is printed, we will have had our Maple Hills 2009 Auction.

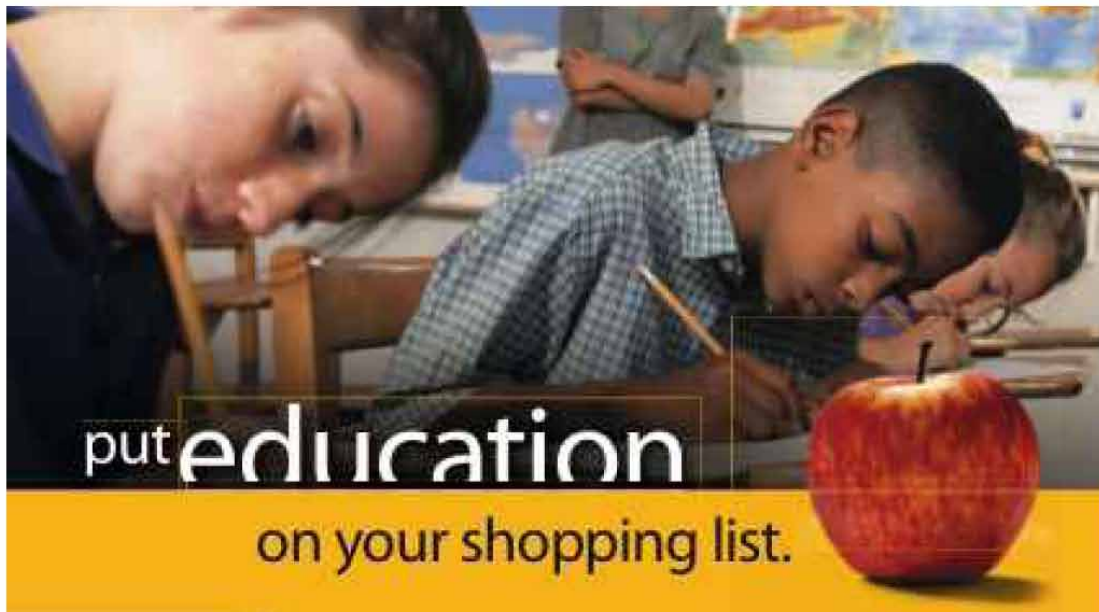
