

MAPLE HILLS EAGLE AWARD

Each year the community of Maple Hills Elementary strives to recognize those individuals who have made a significant and lasting contribution to the education of students at Maple Hills.

This award focuses on significant, lasting, and educational contributions. The nominees are leaders who bring others into action rather than being a “worker bee”. These individuals go above and beyond the normal scope of volunteering. His/her contribution will continue to provide improved access to instruction that is both challenging and beneficial for students. Some examples include:

- Increase levels of achievement by students
- Influence the challenge and expectations of instruction
- Instigate or change educational policies
- Improve the funding for schools, teachers or programs
- Increase the overall level of enthusiasm and participation in volunteerism
- Making programs more user friendly therefore more available
- Changing attitudes that hinder educational programs

The PTA awards its members with the Golden Acorn Award and Outstanding Educator Award. The Eagle Award is an opportunity to include areas not necessarily within the scope of these PTA programs. It is open to the entire community that is involved with the educational programs at Maple Hills Elementary including PTA members and their programs. More than one individual may be awarded and will receive a recognition pin as well as their name added to the existing plaque of previous winners.
